It's a palette that offers a more delicate take on comfort. Forget pops of bright colour and black's dark cloak - stick instead to midnight blues if you need a counterpoint to the lighter hues. Pair with dashes of pink and organic materials in the form of light timbers, cotton and rattan that lend a little textural diversity. Overall, think earthy not dreamy, natural not glossy, and you'll nail this season's cosiest aesthetic in no time.
